This meeting will be very different so please check out the attached agenda and registration materials for our statewide meeting to be held in Sacramento on September 24-26, 2008. This will be a critical meeting to attend starting on Wednesday as we will be having a facilitated discussion of the future of CPAAC.

While we will be following the typical meeting structure of mid-day Wednesday through mid-day Friday, it will be important to be in Sacramento by Noon on Wednesday, September 24th as we will be providing round-trip transportation to an off-site location for the facilitated discussion. Lunch will not be provided that day, so please plan accordingly. We will be meeting at the Marriott Residence Inn, 1121 15th Street in Sacramento at Noon, where round-trip transportation will be provided to a business center in El Dorado Hills. That evening, we will be working together to prepare a gourmet four-course dinner under the guidance of Executive Chef Ezio Gamba at the Masque Ristorante. This will be a fun and entertaining way to get to know other members and enjoy a fine meal before being returned to the hotel in Sacramento.

On Thursday, September 25, 2008, we will continue the tradition of inviting our Sacramento partners to update us on the latest activities, legislation and changes impacting local government and our organizations. In addition to electing our 2009 officers, we will have speakers from CSAC, PERB, and the Governor's Commission on OPEB. We have a full agenda in order to provide you with the latest information from these important partner organizations. The cost of registration is \$175 (payable to CPAAC) and includes both Wednesday and Thursday dinners, lunch on Thursday and all breaks and snacks.
